



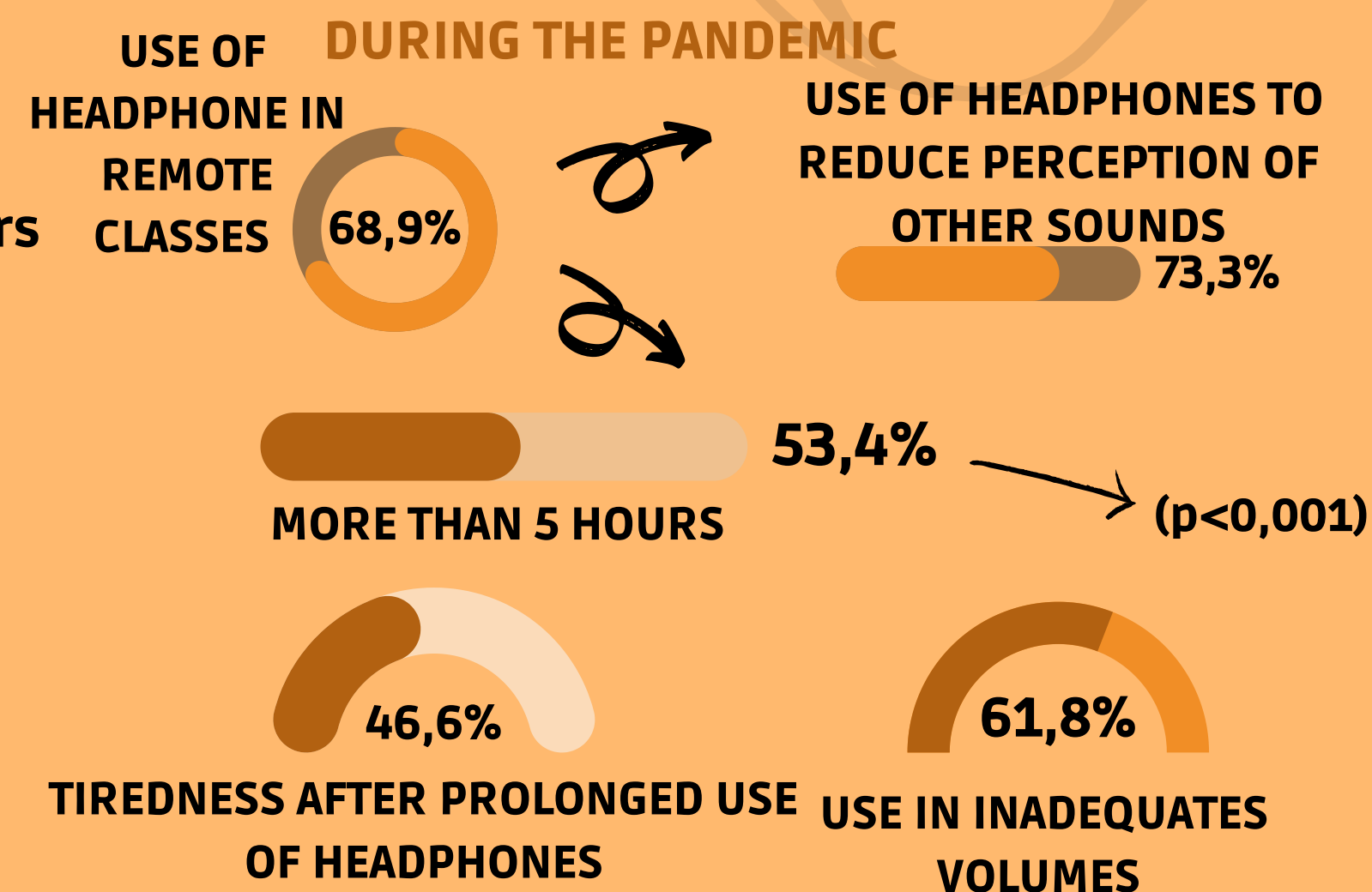
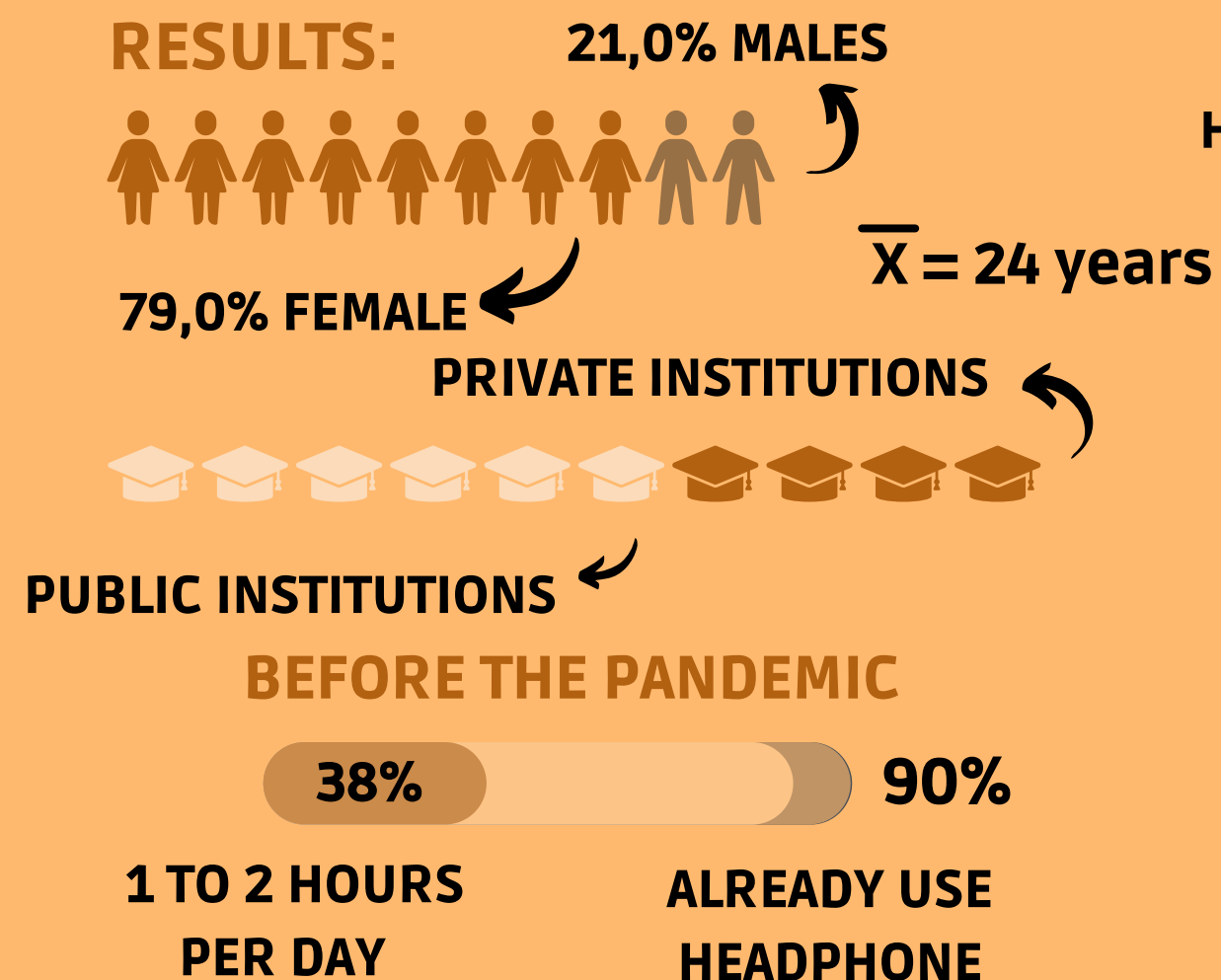
# Use of headphones by university students in remote classes during the pandemic

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**INTRODUCTION:** Due emergence of the Coronavirus pandemic, remote classes and home office were implemented, generating the need to adapt the living environment in order to execute such activities.

**OBJECTIVES:** Analyse the use of headphones to perform remote activities during the pandemic.

**METHODS:** Cross-sectional study with the participation of **190 university students** by answering a questionnaire, prepared by the authors, with questions for the survey of sociodemographic data and the use of headphones during the new Coronavirus pandemic. The study was approved by the Research Ethics Committee of it's Institution (CAAE: 45064720.0.0000.5137).



**CONCLUSION:** The results revealed an increase of hours using headphones, along with their use with volume at an inadequate intensity, pointing to the need for actions of health promotion and prevention of hearing disorders, both directed at the proper use of headphones.
